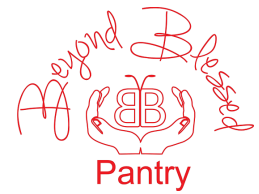


BEYOND BLESSED NEWS

I'm often asked "What does it take to run a food pantry?". Well here is a glimpse behind the scenes! It takes an army to run the food pantry and one of several very important volunteer positions is called a "food pick up person". We rescue food that grocery stores can't sell for various reasons. Typically it's near the end of its shelf life or the packaging is slightly damaged. We work with multiple local stores to pick these items up. Our volunteers then have to transport all the food to our pantry, weigh everything, and sort the good from the bad. We keep the good and donate the "not so good" to some farmers for their animals. Then we store or freeze all the good food so it can be given out on the pantry day. These donations are so helpful to keep our costs down when it comes to purchasing food each week.
